~Group Study:

This month, we will be learning about colors, shapes, letter sounds and numbers. We will be learning about the primary colors (red, blue, and yellow). We will use the primary colors to make the secondary colors (green, purple, and orange). We will also learn about the shapes we see in our day to day life. We will also work more on our letter sounds and numerals.

~Math: This month we will be counting to 30 with our calendar (they really enjoy calendar time☺). We will be reviewing our sandpaper numbers from 0-5. We will also continue counting in English, Spanish, and Chinese.

~Language: During the month, we will introduce a few letter sounds each week do get familiar with our future sound boxes. We are also learning the days of the week and months of the year during calendar time. We also will go over feeling words, so
